- 1. Call to Order Chairman Dederick called the meeting to order at 2:14 p.m. in the Alturas City Council Chambers at 200 W. North Street.
- 2. Public Forum There were no public comments.
- Confirm Agenda Motion by Board Member Hall to confirm agenda, seconded by Board Member Moriarity. All ayes; motion carried.

4. Consent Agenda-

- a. Approve minutes from 02/03/15 MTA Regular Meeting.
- b. YTD expenditures through 02/28/15

Motion by Board Member Hall to approve Consent Agenda items a-c above; seconded by Alternate Board Member Alves. All ayes; motion carried.

5. Regular Business

- a. Consider driver salary increase
 - Director Pedersen presented information indicating the benefits of increasing the base pay for drivers in order to attract drivers and compete with currently offered pay scales. Pedersen mentioned that the wage has been below average since 2012 and MTA has been working since then to increase the salary range to be more competitive. The FTA grants partially used

to fund drivers payroll is not being completely utilized, so there is revenue available for the requested increase. Sage Stage is responsible for more precious cargo and public relations than the surrounding construction companies who start with \$15.00 per hour.

Motion by Board Member Ray to increase base pay for drivers to \$14.50 per hour beginning July 1, 2015, seconded by Board Member Hall. All ayes; motion carried.

b. Special Event Use of Sage Stage multimodal area

• Director Pedersen reported that there hasn't been any interest for usage of the park by vendors at this time. Discussion included the need for permits and insurance, and the idea of the public wanting to use the area for events and birthday parties. The idea will be put on hold for now and we'll watch and see if there are any requests this summer.

c. Surplus Vehicle T-9

Director Pedersen informed the Board that vehicle T-9 is ready to be retired and two new vehicles were received on March 31, 2015. A request has been sent to Caltrans for approval to retire the vehicle. Authorization is also necessary from the Board. The starting bid for T-9 will be \$5,000. At this time, there are no interested parties. An effort will be made to sell the vehicle and if unsuccessful, staff will proceed with public auction.

Motion by Board Member Hall to declare T-9 surplus and authorize Executive Director to advertise, accept sealed bids, open, award and otherwise dispose of vehicle in accordance with MTA Purchasing Policies and Procedures, seconded by Board Member Ray. All ayes; motion carried.

a. Staff Updates

Jacque Dockery, office assistant, presented the System Update as shown. Numbers were down in February due to limited drivers and the resulting canceled routes. Discussion ensued about the Cedarville route ridership and the Susanville Rancheria affecting the Reno service. Director Pedersen mentioned that the ridership will have to pick up in Cedarville in order to maintain funding for that route. At this time we are transporting riders from Ft. Bidwell to Alturas, but not from Cedarville to Alturas. The Susanville Rancheria has not affected our ridership, as yet. Research will be done to determine the best way to include gravel roads on our demand-response service area.
